Cookie notice

To make this Web site work properly, we place small data files called cookies on your computer or mobile device. Most Web sites do this.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a Web site saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the Web site. It enables the Web site to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, display preferences etc.) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to this Web site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies?

A number of our pages can use cookies to remember:

- your display preferences,
- if you have agreed (or not) to our use of cookies on this Web site.

Enabling these cookies is not strictly necessary for the Web site to work, but it will provide you with a better browsing experience. You can delete or block these cookies, but, if you do that, some features of this Web site may not work as intended.

The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally and the pattern data is fully under our control. These cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described here.

Do we use other cookies?

Some of our pages may use additional or different cookies to the ones described above. If so, the details of these cookies will be provided in their specific cookies notice page. You may be asked for your agreement to store these cookies.

How to control cookies?

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish (for details, see www.aboutcookies.org). You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer or mobile device and you can set most Web browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a Web site and some services and functionalities may not work.

Extended information on cookies

Cookies consist of portions of code installed in the Web browser that assist the owner in providing the service according to the purposes described. Some of the purposes of installing cookies may also require the user's consent.

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are used for the sole purpose of providing the services offered by our Web site. The user's prior consent is not required for their installation.

Activities strictly necessary for operation

This Web site uses cookies to save the user's session and to perform other activities that are strictly necessary for the operation of the Web site itself.

Other types of cookies or third-party tools that could use them

Some of the services listed below collect statistics in an aggregate form and may not require the user's consent or may be managed directly by the owner - depending on what is described - without the help of third parties.
